

Nampa Citywide Transportation Plan Goals and Objectives – Draft

March 17, 2009

The Purpose of the Nampa Citywide Transportation Plan is to conceptually define a safe roadway system that meets the city's transportation mobility needs through the year 2035 and identify the means to create that system.

This Transportation Plan has two broad goals and supporting objectives:

1. Develop a fiscally constrained, prioritized blueprint for improving and expanding the transportation roadway system throughout the City of Nampa and its proposed Area of City Impact.
Objectives:
 - i. Collect accurate baseline information about the existing transportation system;
 - ii. Conduct a comprehensive needs assessment highlighting safety, preservation and improvement projects needed for the roadway system by 2035;
 - iii. Implement a thoughtful evaluation, cost estimation and prioritization of projects identified in the needs assessment, consistent with the City of Nampa's Comprehensive Plan;
 - iv. Identify, evaluate and quantify funding sources that are likely to be available to fund higher priority projects;
 - v. Define interim safety/preservation/improvement programs for years 2010, 2015, 2020, 2025 and 2035 that best utilize the anticipated revenue stream.

2. Conduct a planning process that uses resources in a fiscally prudent manner:
Objectives:
 - i. Manage and coordinate the planning process to maximize efficiency and cost-effectiveness
 - ii. Utilize City of Nampa resources, when available, to minimize out-of-pocket costs to the city;
 - iii. Interact with the public and stakeholder groups throughout the planning process in a timely and informative manner
 - iv. Emphasize inter-agency collaboration, coordination and cooperation with all participating agencies
