Community Committee to Help Plan Transportation Improvements

(Friday, March 13, 2009) The Nampa Transportation Master Plan Community Advisory Committee will meet for the first time Thursday, March 19 as part of an ongoing citywide planning process for short- and long-term improvements to Nampa's transportation system.

Committee members represent stakeholder groups such as education, business, property owners, citizens, elected officials and advocacy groups.

"We have a great opportunity to continue to be proactive and plan for future needs and growth in the City of Nampa," said Mayor Tom Dale. "The citizens serving on the Community Advisory Committee represent a good cross section of our community. By sharing their concerns and ideas, this group, along with our consultants and staff, can help to create a solid transportation plan that will meet the future needs of our entire city."

The Nampa Citywide Transportation Plan addresses automobile, freight, transit, pedestrian and bicycle traffic needs through the year 2035.

The first meeting will be held at the Nampa Civic Center from 3:30 p.m. to 6 p.m. Thursday, March 19. All committee meetings will be open to the public.

The Nampa Citywide Transportation Plan is expected to be complete in late 2009. The completed plan will be presented to the Nampa City Council for adoption.
