PLANNING SCHEDULE

EARLY 2009

- Develop goals and objectives
- Gather public input through this survey
- Host first Community Advisory Committee meeting
- Collect traffic data

SPRING 2009

- Identify the long-range transportation needs
- Host Community Advisory Committee meeting

SUMMER 2009

- Prioritize transportation improvements based on estimated future funding
- Host Community Advisory Committee meeting

FALL 2009

- Host public open house to present and gather input on the draft plan
- Host the final Community Advisory Committee meeting

The draft plan is expected to be complete in late 2009 and will be presented to the Nampa City Council for adoption.
