**Discussion Items:**

**1. Year in Review – 2022**

- Midland Corridor Project

Matt Ricks presented the public outreach results from the Midland Corridor Study project. He also showed the two options for the roadway sections that were brought before the public in an online survey and in a public open house.

- State Highway 16 Specific Area Plan

Breanna Son presented the SH-16 Specific Area Plan that is anticipated to be adopted on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. She explained that the pathways and bike routes that are in the Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan were incorporated into this plan. Additionally, she shared with the Committee how the Ten Mile, Purdam, and Railroad pathway crossings are being accommodated when crossing State Highway 16.

- Hwy 20/26 Specific Area Plan

Breanna Son presented the Hwy 20/26 Specific Area Plan that is anticipated to be adopted on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. She explained that the pathways and bike routes that are in the Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan were incorporated into this plan. Additionally, she shared with the Committee that the Hwy 20/26 has suggested locations for trailheads with parking dispersed throughout the plan.

**2. Looking Ahead – 2023**

- Central Nampa Planning Area

Breanna Son shared with the Committee that in 2023, the Planning & Zoning Department is looking to revise two planning documents previously adopted related to “North Nampa” and “Central Nampa”. The planning area is generally north of the Downtown and railroad tracks, but the exact scope has yet to be determined. If additional bike-ped planning, beyond the Master Plan, is necessary, the Committee will be consulted.

- West Nampa Planning Area

Breanna Son shared with the Committee that in 2023, the Planning & Zoning Department is looking to prepare a Specific Area Plan for the west Nampa area. The exact scope has yet to be determined. If additional bike-ped planning, beyond the Master Plan, is necessary, the Committee will be consulted.

**New Business:**

**1. COMPASS Permanent Bike-Ped Counter Installation**

Dane Hoskins presented to the Committee that COMPASS has funding to install 4-5 permanent counters within Canyon County. Dane provided a description and overview of the two counters available to us. Additionally, Dane shared a map of the locations with existing counters. Following Dane's presentation, the Committee worked on a mapping activity where they placed notes and identified locations where they felt a permanent counter would be useful within the City of Nampa.

**Open Discussion:**

The Committee shared what they are interested in learning more, or where they felt improvements needed to be made for the upcoming year:

- Pedestrian safety while crossing roundabouts
- Making undeveloped pathways a priority and protect corridors and routes to Lake Lowell, and south around Lake Lowell.
- Ensuring striping for bike lanes and shared lanes are properly maintained
