1. New Business

1.1 Approve January 11th, 2021 minutes – **Action Item**

***MOTION:** Commissioner Wormser moved to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Volkert seconded. The motion passed unanimously.*

1.2 Parking Garage mural permit approval - Collin Pfeifer– **Action Item**

The artists of Sector Seventeen have been given an opportunity to paint a community mural series by T-mobile and would like to use the 11th Ave side of the Downtown Parking Garage for the Canyon County location. The artists are working on a tight timeline due to the grant requirements and are requesting for permit review in advance of them seeking formal permission from Nampa Development Corp, who are the owners of the garage. The commissioners discussed the mural and appreciated and approved of the concept.

***MOTION:** Commissioner Wormser moved to approve the “De La Tierra” mural by Sector Seventeen on the condition that they receive permission and have a signed Affidavit of Legal Interest from the Nampa Development Corporation. Commissioner Jenkins seconded. The motion passed unanimously.*

1.3 Parking Garage mural letter of recommendation – **Action Item**

Staff has requested that the AHPC have a formal letter of support that can be provided to the NDC commissioners as part of their meeting packet as they consider the placement of the mural.

***MOTION:** Commissioner Manning moved to authorize the chair to sign a letter of support for the mural to be included with NDC meeting materials. Commissioner Wormser seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.*

1.4 Dewey Hotel Mural – Chris Fonseca - **Action Item**

*Chris Fonseca of SECA art presented on options that could be considered for the preservation of the Dewey Mural on the Leavitt Engineering Building. The options include a typical refresh/restoration, designing a new piece, based on a timeline concept, that uses the Dewey Palace portion of the existing mural and incorporates new art and the idea of doing something completely new on that wall. The commission discussed different fundraising options and the timeline of discussing this with all of relevant stakeholders. In order to better evaluate the options, we will need to figure out pricing, the investment level of the property owner and which option they would prefer. **NO FORMAL ACTION***

1.5 DH Code Revision Review – Beth Ineck – **Action Item**

*Beth gave a very general overview of the changes that are being proposed to the Downtown Historic chapter of the zoning code. The biggest changes include adding more review authority to the AHPC and clarifications on design elements.
