

Nampa Golf Commission Meeting Notes 8/21/18

Not Official Meeting: With only three of seven Commission members present, and therefore lacking a quorum, this meeting was discussion only and no official Commission business was discussed, and no decisions were made.

Meeting began in the Ridgecrest clubhouse at 11:50 AM.

Revenue & Expense Reports: Revenue was up for both courses in July, and expenses appeared to be normal. Jennifer Vanderpool noted that revenue and expense totals should now all be accurate following the installation of the new financial system in late May. Scott Nicholes indicated that August expenses for Ridgecrest will include replacement the commercial dishwasher in the kitchen and repair of the range pall picking machine, both unforeseen expenses.

Maintenance Reports: Charlie Denham reported for Ridgecrest that a pump station motor failed in July, compounding the previous irrigation equipment problems we've had, but it's now repaired and irrigation has been going as planned for the last couple weeks. Aeration is scheduled for 9/4 for the Championship Course, and 9/10 for the Wee Nine. Brandon Crim reported for Centennial that irrigation is going well, greens were sprayed on 8/20, and aeration is scheduled for 9/5. Dave Clausen commented that he's played Centennial several times in recent weeks and the course looks in good condition and plays well. Scott Jacobsen commented that Ridgecrest playing conditions were good and greens were running smoothly.

Public Relations Reports: Steve Wilson read the written reports received from Linda Estes and June York. Linda Estes reported for Centennial that a Spector Tournament was held on 7/19 with 66 players, a Jr. Golf Camp on 7/23-26 with 8-12 players each day, and a St Paul's Baptist Church event was held on 7/28 with 64 players. An IGA Jr. Tournament was held on 7/30-31, SNAG Days on 8/1-2, an Alliance Dairy tournament on 8/3 with 60 players and the CMGA Alternate Shot Tournament was held on 8/4. The Sr. Men's Championship took place on 8/8-8/9, and the "Ryder Cup" on 8/18-19. June York reported for Ridgecrest that a PGA Jr. League event was held on 7/20 versus Redhawk as was a Title I event, and another PGA Jr. League on 7/21 versus Fairview. A Treasure Valley Golf Tour event was held on 7/25-26, another Title I event on 7/27, IGA Juniors on 7/30-31 and PGA Junior League on 8/3. The RMGA Club Championship was held on 8/4-5, an Executive Women's Golf Assoc., event on 8/6 with 24 players, and the Nampa Jr. League Championship was held on 8/7. The RLGA Club Championship was held on 8/11-12, Junior Camps on 8/13-16, a memorial for Dick Lord (Ridgecrest Marshall) on 8/14, the St. Al's annual tournament on 8/17 with a full field, and the Nampa Cup Individual matches (Ridgecrest and Centennial Ladies and men) on 8/19.

Golf Course Lease: Scott Nicholes indicated that he had spoken with Mayor Kling after she and Nampa Representative Rick Youngblood recently met with the director of Department of Health & Welfare (DHW). The mayor indicated that the meeting was cordial and went well, but that

DHW is unable to commit to anything until after the election when we will have a new governor. Bobby Sanchez indicated that the mayor would like to have a new long-term lease or lease to own negotiated with DHW by the end of December. The current lease expires 12/31/19.

The informal meeting concluded at 12:20 PM.
