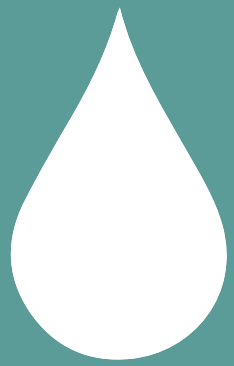


# THE FUTURE OF NAMPA'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT RECYCLED WATER PROGRAM



## COMMUNITY CONSENSUS

Identified by citizens as the best decision for Nampa. The Recycled Water Program evolved from community feedback through Nampa's Wastewater Advisory Group.



## CONSERVATION

The right water for the right use. Nutrients left in the water are beneficial for irrigated areas, and the water is used locally, rather than being sent downstream.



## COST SAVINGS

The reduction in treatment costs will save customers an estimated \$17 million.



## COLLABORATION

Pioneer Irrigation District has been serving Nampa since 1901 and the permit will strengthen our partnership.



## COMMERCE

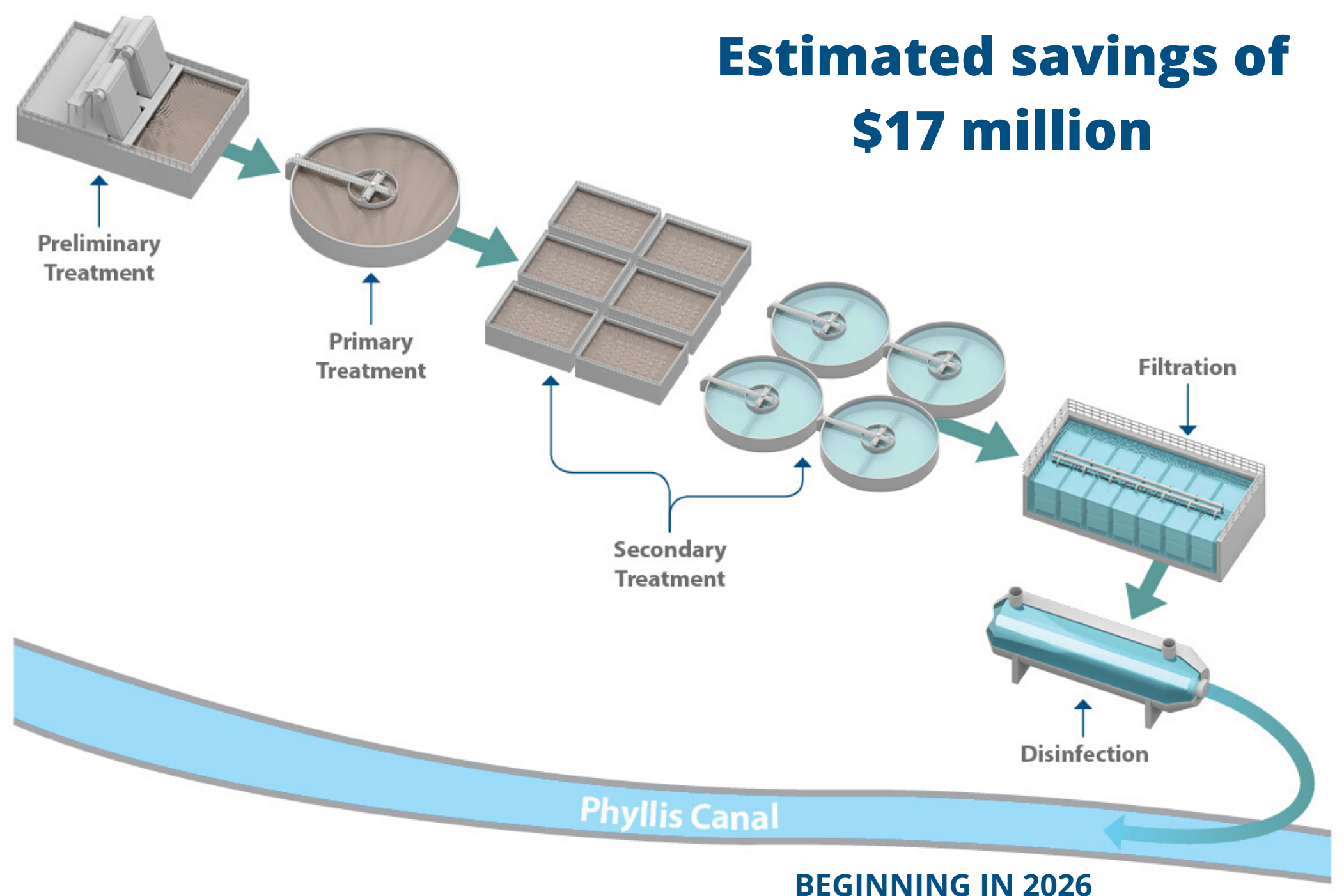
Paving the way for future economic development, recycled water use can be expanded for industrial and commercial purposes.

## THE WATER TREATMENT PROCESS

The City of Nampa is developing a Recycled Water Program which will reuse highly treated, **Class A** recycled water in the community.

Class A means this water meets the **strictest standards** established by the IDEQ and is safe for its use.

The City of Nampa will use Class A recycled water for irrigation purposes such as lawns, gardens, parks and other industrial processes.
