Ford Idaho Center and Nampa Civic Center to Cancel or Postpone all Gatherings Over 250 People

NAMPA, Idaho (March 13, 2020)—Following an emergency resolution approved by the City of Nampa limiting mass gatherings at city venues, the Ford Idaho Center and Nampa Civic Center will be canceling all gatherings that exceed 250 people, effective immediately.

On Friday, March 13, the Nampa City Council approved the emergency resolution as a precautionary measure and out of respect for guidance recently released from Southwest District Health regarding mass gatherings and public events in Idaho. The resolution reads: **“Gatherings of 250 people or more for social, entertainment, commercial, recreational or other activities of any kind are prohibited at the Ford Idaho Center and Nampa Civic Center.”**

The prohibition shall be effective immediately through midnight of March 31, 2020.

Both venues are currently working to reschedule all performances that were scheduled from March 13 to March 31 and will provide updates as quickly as possible. Please note fans are encouraged to retain their tickets for a cancelled or postponed event.
