Erosion & Sediment Control Permit Submittal Requirements

Sites Disturbing One or More Acre(s) of Land Require the Following:

- A complete '*Site Development, And/Or Erosion & Sediment Control Permit*' application. The complete application includes:
 - Name of Responsible Person with their City of Boise certification number and expiration date.
 - Contact information including phone number for the Responsible Person.
 - Project Name and site address. Name of the contractor if known.
 - Permit fee is Eighty dollars per acre and based on project site acreage rounded to the nearest half acre (1.49 rounds to 1 acre, 1.5 acre rounds to 2 acres).
 - Notice of Intent (NOI) number from the EPA website (Fourteen day waiting period required).
 - Signature of applicant along with the date.

- Two copies of the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) designed for the project site. Also referred to as SWPPP narratives. A copy of the EPA Construction General Permit is required with the SWPPP. Include dewatering plans if applicable.

- Two Erosion & Sediment Control site plans designed for the project site.

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Sites Disturbing Less Than One Acre of Land

- A complete '*Compliance Notice For Site Development and Erosion, Sediment & Fugitive Dust Control On Construction Sites Less Than One Acre*' application. The complete application includes:
 - Project Name and address.
 - Name and Certification number of Responsible Person along with required contact information. Expiration date of certification number.
 - Applicant printed name and title, signature and date.
 - Permit fee if required.

- Two copies of the Specific Construction Site Discharge Control Plan Requirements narrative.

Note: The Erosion & Sediment Control application for construction sites less than one acre contains general guidelines for compliance. Additional information concerning these guidelines is available upon request. Applicant signature signifies understanding and acceptance of these terms and conditions.
