IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project Background

Franklin Boulevard is designated as a **critical freight corridor** for the Treasure Valley.

Recent growth has produced traffic that exceeds the roadway capacity and delays freight and commercial deliveries.

A 2017 technical study determined traffic operations could be improved by:

- Increasing the distance between intersections.
- Relocating some approaches further from I-84 ramps.
- Increasing turning radius for large trucks.

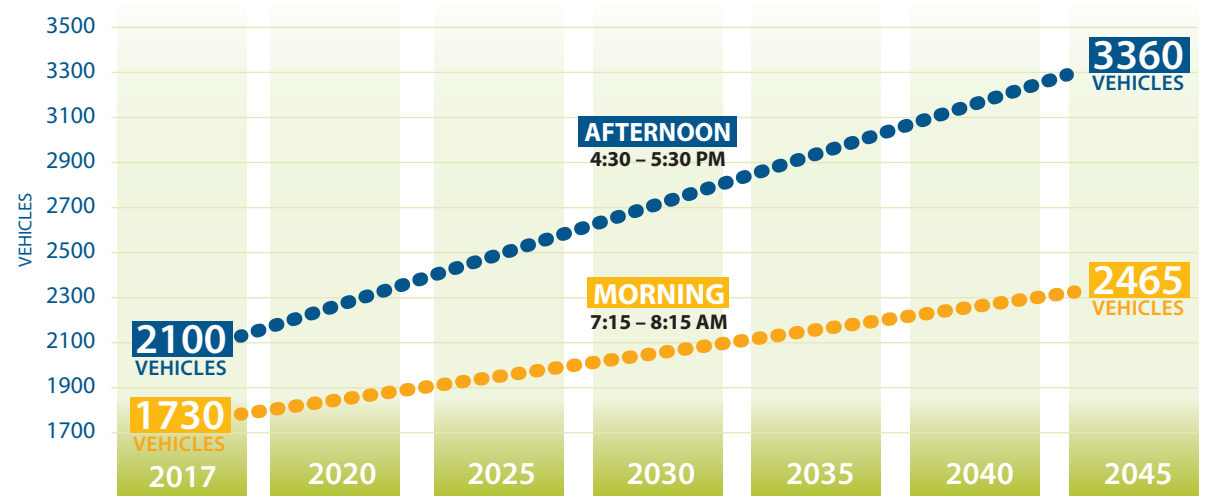

IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Current and projected traffic volumes

Without improvements, traffic increases will cause considerable delays, especially for vehicles turning left from 3rd Avenue N. and Industrial Road.

Traffic on Franklin Boulevard is expected to significantly increase over the next 25 years during the morning and afternoon commutes.

Process and schedule

EARLY 2021

- ✓ Develop a range of improvement options
- ✓ Conduct an environmental scan and traffic analysis of the project area
- ✓ Contact residents and businesses to discuss the project

SPRING 2021

- Select a subset of improvements for further evaluation
- **Present options and gather input from the community**
- Recommend one improvement to move forward to preliminary design
