Roles and Responsibilities

The purpose of the Nampa Stormwater Advisory Group (NSWAG) is to provide input and guidance to the City of Nampa's Stormwater Program, help with special project development and implementation and assist the city in its continued effort to provide stormwater education and outreach to the community in Nampa.

Membership

Members Represent:

- Developers, business/industry and commercial interests
- Hispanic business owners and professionals
- Residents, neighborhoods and homeowner's associations
- Civic, school and nonprofit organizations
- Elected officials
- Low income and minority groups
- Environmental groups
- Construction contractors

Responsibilities of group members

Members of the advisory group are asked to:

- Actively participate in meetings
- Represent the needs and opinions of their businesses or organizations
- Review and give input on the Stormwater Program
- Provide guidance to the city on how best to:
 - Educate the public about stormwater problems and what they can do to improve water quality
 - Design and placement of interpretive signage along Indian Creek
 - Involve the Hispanic community of Nampa in the stormwater discussion
 - Measure the success of public outreach and education

Responsibilities of Nampa city staff

The city will lead the advisory group. In addition, city staff will provide the advisory group with:

- Background information about the Stormwater Program
- Education about technical concepts
- Prompt responses to questions
- Documentation of meetings and feedback

City staff will respect the limited time and schedules of advisory group members. Meetings will start and end on time.
