Notice & Submittal Requirements

All work within a designated floodplain area shall adhere to Nampa City Code §4-9, "Flood Damage Prevention". A Floodplain Development Permit shall be obtained prior to commencing with development activities within a designated floodplain area as defined in the code. Failure to obtain a permit may result in project delays and involve penal action as determined by the City. The permit will not be issued until all other necessary local, state or federal permits have been obtained. The permit will expire if work does not commence within six months of the date of issue.

Floodplain information can be obtained from the FEMA Flood Map Service Center (<https://msc.fema.gov/portal/home>) or City of Nampa Engineering Division website (<https://www.cityofnampa.us/182/Floodplain-Information>).

Application shall include the following items to be deemed complete:

- Completed and signed application
- Detailed Site Plan reflecting proposed improvements relative to the Floodplain/Floodway boundary
- Topographic/Grading Plan reflecting existing and proposed grades tied to NAVD88 vertical datum
- Copy of applications made to other agencies (*IDWR, Idaho Fish & Game, Army Corp of Engineers, Irrigation District, etc.*)
