What works well for people today on Midland Boulevard



- When there is a center left-turn lane it is helpful for making turns into driveways and side streets -57% (139 responses)

What are your concerns?

Motor vehicle traffic is too congested (180)

It takes too long to turn onto Midland Boulevard from side streets or my driveway (140)

I don't feel safe waiting to make a left-turn off Midland Boulevard when there is no center left-turn lane (126)

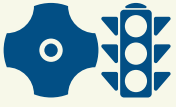


I don't feel safe biking in the street

TOP 5 PRIORITIES FOR MIDLAND BOULEVARD



1. Putting in turn lanes, signals, or roundabouts at intersections with higher traffic volumes to make it easier to turn onto Midland Boulevard



2. Adding more lanes to Midland Boulevard to reduce motor vehicle congestion



3. Adding a center turn lane to Midland Boulevard where there is not one already



4. Providing sidewalks

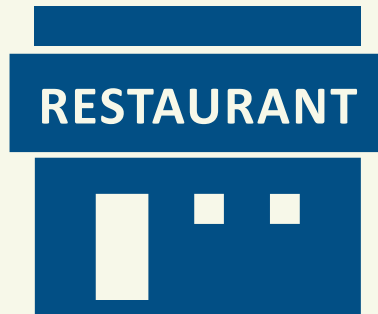


5. Improving crossings of Midland Boulevard for people walking and biking
