PRESS RELEASE

On April 19th, 2014 at 9:36 p.m. Nampa Dispatch received a call for a vehicle versus pedestrian accident at 15th Ave. and 7th St. S. As a result of the investigation Officers determined that two pedestrians received minor injuries, after being struck by a motorcycle, while legally crossing 7th St. S. The victims were a 62 year old female from Dover Idaho and a 69 year old female from Candenton Missouri. Both females were taken to a local hospital. The motorcycle operator, 42 year old Nampa resident Harold F. Glover, was charged with two misdemeanors, Driving Without Privileges and Inattentive Driving.

At the time of the accident there was a high wind storm in the area and the motorcycle rider was not wearing eye protection. The wind storm and debris caused him to have blurred vision.
