April 24, 2014, Nampa Idaho- **Long time Nampa Police employee Stacy Mowry retires after 32 years of service in law enforcement**

The Nampa Police Department is announcing the retirement of Lieutenant Stacy Mowry. After 30 years of service to the City of Nampa, Mowry is calling it a career.

Stacy Mowry started with the Nampa Police in 1982 as a Nampa Police Reserve Officer. He worked as a Canyon County Deputy in 1984 and returned to Nampa Police as a patrolman in 1986. He has held the rank of Corporal, Sergeant and Lieutenant. Mowry has earned the distinction of being awarded the Nampa Police Silver Star, the Life Saving Award and also a Good Conduct award.

Mowry holds a Bachelors' of Science in Criminal Justice Administration from Boise State University and has over 2800 training hours logged with the Idaho POST Academy. He is a POST certified instructor in the fields of use of force, RADAR, impact tools and Controlled Force.

"Be patient and supportive. This is a great place to work. Don't let the little things get to you. Keep the big picture in mind." said Mowry when asked to impart some wisdom to the Nampa Police family.

He plans on traveling to Europe with his beautiful wife Michel' and enjoying time with family. He has plans to grow his beard and to turn his hobby of sewing into a full time small business called "The Kilted Tailor." He often sews men's skirts and models them for his co-workers. He calls them "kilts".

"Stacy has worked for the citizens of this community for the past 3 decades in a manner that encompasses both compassion and honor. In 1996 Stacy was awarded a life saving medal for helping save several people from the Gray Stone Hotel fire. This selfless act exemplifies his law enforcement career. It has been an honor working with him. I will miss him." Nampa Police Chief Kingsbury said.

Friends and colleagues are recognizing his career and his achievements Wednesday, April 30 at 2 p.m., at the Nampa Civic Center with awards and presentations from local leaders and some of the many Law Enforcement professionals who have worked alongside Mowry over the past three decades.
