NAMPA POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESS RELEASE

May 2, 2014- Nampa, Idaho

The Nampa Police Department in conjunction with the Greater Idaho Fugitive Task Force capture fugitive, Vicente Prieto, in a Nampa residence late last evening.

Prieto has recently been featured on the Idaho Crime Stoppers Most Wanted list for several warrants and vehicle pursuits with police.

Early Thursday morning, Nampa Police detectives and the task force received information that Prieto may be in the Nampa area and began following leads to his whereabouts. During the course of the investigation, they learned he was in a residence in the 1700 block of 3rd Street South in Nampa. At approximately 11 p.m., Prieto surrendered to police without incident.

At the time of his arrest, Prieto was suffering from a self-inflicted gun-shot wound to his lower leg. The wound had occurred several days prior to the arrest and was in need of immediate medical attention due to infection. He was transported by Nampa police to a local hospital where he was treated and released back into police custody.

Prieto was transported to Canyon County Jail and booked in for multiple warrants from various jurisdictions. Warrants include Eluding (F), Possession of Paraphernalia (M), Obstruct and Delay (M), two counts of Aggravated Battery (F), two counts of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm (F), Driving without Privileges (M), Trespassing (M), Petit Theft (M), Probation Violations for Domestic Battery and for Violation of a No Contact Order (M), Windshield Obstruction (M) and Operating a Motor Vehicle with No Insurance (M). Bond amounts are in excess of \$360,000. Other charges are pending as Prieto's criminal activities are still under investigation.
