PRESS RELEASE

On 05/13/14 at approximately 11:42 p.m., Nampa Police stopped a Green 2014 Dodge Grand Caravan on Interstate 84 near Milepost 37 for observed traffic violations. After making contact with the occupants of the vehicle, the officer could smell the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

A Nampa Police K-9 unit was called to the scene and the K-9 alerted to the presence of the odor of a controlled substance in the vehicle. During a subsequent search of the vehicle officers located approximately 6.5 pounds of marijuana and 1 pound of suspected psilocybin mushrooms, total value at approximately 42,000 dollars. Several items of drug paraphernalia and a substantial amount of cash were also collected as evidence in the vehicle.

The three occupants in the vehicle, were arrested for drug trafficking and were booked into the Canyon County Jail. Arrested was Billie L. Bird, 60 years of age from Cottage Grove, OR, Skye-Ann K. Howard, 41 years of age and Seth L. Shreefer, 43 years of age, both from Portland, OR.
