

Overview

Description - This SOP is to control domestic water usage for construction projects and various other instances of water usage outside of regular domestic use.

Purpose/Rationale - In an effort to eliminate the cross connection created by the use of hydrants meters used in the water system, our department is implementing the new Orange Box Water program. Our department is currently phasing out the hydrant meter program.

Applicability - Companies and Individuals that use unmetered Nampa domestic water for construction purposes and various other instances of water usage outside of regular domestic use.

Failure to Comply - Non-compliance of this policy could cause contamination to the current water system.

1. General

- A. It is the policy of the City of Nampa Waterworks Division to ensure the safety and reliability of our city's water system.
- B. The Waterworks Division is implementing the Orange Box Water Program for all contractors and individual users of our current hydrant meter program.
- C. This program will be in place from March 1 until November 1 each year, barring freezing temperatures that may cause late start or early cutoff.
- D. Accommodations for water for construction projects after November 1st until March 1st may be made on a case by case basis as verified by Public Works Construction Inspectors.
- E. Any hydrant meters authorized for use between November 1st and March 1st will follow the Hydrant Meter Policy WW-010-002.

2. Orange Box Water Program:

- A. Orange water dispensing stations will be available throughout various locations within the city designated by Waterworks staff.
- B. Water will be paid for by individual Tokens that can be purchased at the Waterworks office on 24 1st St South, Nampa, Idaho 83687.

Water Access Points

Orange Boxes: Uses tokens (Please note a 3" camlock female adapter is required)

Orange boxes require tokens, which can be purchase at the Waterworks Dept.

One token is \$.25. There is a minimum of \$5.00 and a maximum of \$20.00 \$.25 = 250 gallons

1. Treasure Valley Market Place- located behind Orthopedic Care
2. North of Nampa Christian High School – North of Flamingo on Midway
3. Greenhurst / Midland – West of Midland on Greenhurst

Coin Op (uses quarters) .25= 250 gallons Water Department – (24 1st St South)

- Top Fill
- 1.5" (Camlock Fem. Adapter)
- 3.0" (Camlock Fem. Adapter)

Pressurized Irrigation Hydrants (Purple Hydrant) Tanker Fill Stations

(Must use hydrant wrench, standard 2 ½" fire hose hookup)

There is no fee to use the purple hydrants

4. On Birch West of Idaho Center Boulevard (6266 Birch Ln)
5. Idaho Center- between Equine Dr and Tiegs
6. On Lake Lowell East of Middleton Road
7. On Iowa Ave East of Middleton Road (E. Iowa Ave, E of Middleton Rd)
8. On Sunnyridge North of Meadow Road (2731 Sunny Ridge Rd)
