VEHICLE VS. PEDESTRAIN FATAL CRASH IN NAMPA

On 02/26/16 at 7:51 a.m., Nampa police officers were dispatched to the Chevron at 5950 East Franklin Road for a vehicle vs. pedestrian crash.

Upon arrival, officers found that a silver 2011 Dodge Durango had run over an adult male in the parking lot of the gas station. The driver of the Durango was identified as a 27-year-old Nampa female. The male that was struck by the Durango was identified as Boise resident Jose Campos-Sanchez, 37 years old.

The victim was transported to a Boise hospital, where he succumbed to the injuries sustained in the crash. The crash is still under investigation by Nampa police officers. No charges have been filed at this time. There is no suspicion that drugs or alcohol were a factor in this crash. There is a possibility that the bright sun during this time was a vision obstruction and a contributing factor in this incident.
