Stabbing reported in City of Nampa

On 03/10/16 at 4:51 p.m., Nampa police officers were dispatched to the 800 block of W. Kinghorn Drive for a report of a stabbing that had just occurred.

Upon arrival at the residence, officers located the victim of the stabbing. The victim is a 30 year-old Nampa resident. The victim was transported by ambulance to a local hospital. His condition is not known at this time.

“Witnesses advised that an argument ensued between two males in front of the garage at the residence. During the altercation one male subject stabbed the victim in the abdomen and then fled the scene,” said Sergeant Tim Riha.

The suspect in this case is known by the victim. The suspect is a white male who has short brown hair, was wearing glasses and a long sleeved shirt. The suspect and a female left the scene in possibly a cream or tan colored, early 90’s Dodge, regular cab pickup truck. The pickup has a darker brown stripe down the side of the truck that is approximately 4 inches wide. The suspect vehicle possibly has Jerome county plates (2J).

“At this time, we do not think that there is any danger to the general public. It was reported to police that the suspect and victim know each other,” Riha said.

The female that fled with the suspect has been identified as Ashley Ford, a 27 year-old female. She is a person of interest in this case.
