Nampa stabbing now being investigated as a homicide

Nampa Police are now investigating the stabbing that occurred Thursday as a homicide. The stabbing occurred at about 5 p.m. Thursday in the 800 block of W. Kinghorn Drive in Nampa. The 30-year old male victim was transported to a local hospital. He later died of his injuries sustained in the stabbing.

“The Nampa Police Department is sad to report that the victim in this case suffered fatal injuries in the altercation that occurred last night,” said Sergeant Tim Riha. “We are still asking for help from the public in locating 27-year-old Ashley Ford,” Riha said.

Ashley Ford is a person of interest in this case. She was seen leaving the scene with the suspect in this case. At this time there is no further information on the suspect in the homicide. However, police believe the suspect in this case is known by the victim. The suspect is a white male who has short brown hair, was wearing glasses and a long sleeved shirt.

Nampa police detectives, with the assistance of other law enforcement agencies, are actively investigating this case and are attempting to locate the suspect and Ashley Ford. Nampa police is not releasing the name of the victim at this time, pending notification of the next of kin.

As stated Thursday, police do not believe there is any danger to the general public.
