Nampa Police make firearms, controlled substance and warrant arrests

On March 30, 2016, at approximately 6:24 p.m., Nampa Police officers observed David O. Salas, a 28-year-old Nampa resident, enter a residence in the 200 block of 1st St. N. in Nampa. Salas had a \$50,000.00 felony warrant for his arrest for a probation violation. The warrant was for aggravated battery and use of a deadly weapon.

Due to the violent history of Salas, the Nampa Police Department Tactical Response Team (TRT) was asked to respond to the scene. While the TRT team was mobilizing, officers on scene observed Salas exit the back of the residence and get into the rear seat of a white Ford Explorer SUV. At that time, officers approached the vehicle and Salas was taken into custody without incident. Salas, a prohibited possessor of weapons, had several firearms in his possession at the time of his arrest.

The TRT team arrived at the scene and cleared the residence and no one else was located inside of the house.

The driver of the white Ford Explorer was identified as Katie M. Smith, a 33-year-old Nampa resident. She was arrested for possession of methamphetamine, possession of marijuana and driving while suspended. Salas was charged with unlawful possession of firearms and the felony warrant. Both subjects were booked into the Canyon County Jail.
