### **Nampa Police respond to Memorial Day stabbing**

On May 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:55 p.m., Nampa Police Officers responded to a call of a possible stabbing in the 900 block of Chicago Street. Upon arrival, officers found that a 45-year-old male had been stabbed. He was transported to a local hospital to be treated for his injuries. The victim in this case is believed to be a Boise resident. His current medical condition is unknown.

Nampa Police Detectives were called to the scene to conduct the investigation, which is still ongoing. The Nampa Police Department is looking for help from the public in locating a person of interest in this case. He is identified by police as Raymond "Sean" Strickland, a 44-year-old Nampa resident. He is described as 6'1", 180 lbs, brown hair and brown eyes. He possibly has a shaved head and wears a goatee. Strickland is believed to be in a vehicle that appears to be a late 90's Isuzu Rodeo that is black in color. The vehicle also has a primer gray hood and front fenders and bears Idaho license plates.
