## SUMMER CONSTRUCTION PROJECT - RUNWAY PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

### *RUNWAY CLOSED – September 11-15, 2017*

Our engineers and FAA have identified Nampa's runway 11-29 and its parallel taxiway are in need of crack-repair and sealcoating. The Airport has accepted an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant for the project. The project is scheduled to begin September 11 and be completed September 15. This will require the runway and taxiway be closed Monday, September 11 through Friday, September 15. The Caldwell Airport has kindly offered tie-downs at no charge if your aircraft needs to be temporarily based. The majority of funding for this project will be provided through an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant issued by the FAA and Idaho State Aeronautics. Please exercise care and caution if driving or taxiing near construction zones.

### THE TOWER GRILL

Have you checked out our new airport café? The Tower Grill opened in the Fall of 2016 in the upstairs Terminal building and immediately garnered a loyal following. ### DID YOU KNOW??

The present location for the Nampa Airport was established in the early 1920's. There were three runways set up in a triangle with the longest stretching about 2500 feet. After additional property was purchased in the 1970's, the two short runways were abandoned, and the main runway direction was changed to its present location and lengthened to 4045 feet. During the 1980's several new hangars were built. During the 1990's, the terminal building and more hangars were built, and additional adjoining property was purchased. In 1996 and 1997, the runway was lengthened to its current length of 5000 feet.
