Tree Maintenance Is Necessary For Health and Safety!

Did you know that residents, business owners, and tenants are responsible for maintaining trees on private property, along with any trees located upon adjacent public rights of ways, such as; the area between your property line and the street, including sidewalks and alleys?

Routine maintenance of trees on public rights of ways is required, along with any trees located on private property which may be encroaching into the public rights of ways or which may affect public property from being in a safe, healthy condition.

Routine maintenance would consist of removing dead limbs and pruning trees so that branches that they are kept a minimum vertical distance above the sidewalk of eight feet (8') over the sidewalk and a minimum vertical distance of fourteen feet (14') over the street. In addition, any tree branches or shrubs that are obstructing the vision of street signs, stop signs, or clearance at intersections are required to be trimmed. Please ensure that all branches, leaves and wood are removed from the property once pruning has been completed.
