

## Que puedo hacer queando esperando la cita?

**La integridad de la investigación policial es imprescindible para la calidad del caso. Le pedimos que mientras espera la cita de su hijo, haga lo siguiente:**

- **CREE A SU NIÑO!**
- No le haga preguntas a su hijo sobre lo que sucedió. Queremos que su divulgación al entrevistador sea auténtica. Por favor, no tenga más discusiones sobre lo que sucedió con él o ella.
- Si su hijo inicia la conversación sobre lo que sucedió, por favor solo escuche. Documente lo que su hijo le dijo y dígale a su hijo, "Gracias por compartir eso conmigo"
- No enfrente al sospechoso en el caso. Con el fin de obtener los mejores resultados en la investigación le pedimos que mantenga lo que su hijo divulgó confidencial.
- Cuando se prepare para la entrevista, dígale a su hijo que va a ver a un médico para asegurarse de que su cuerpo está bien. Anime a su hijo a ser honesto acerca de lo que sucedió.
- Continúe la rutina habitual de su hijo
- Adherirse al plan de seguridad establecido por el oficial de patrulla

# Now That You've Reported to Police:

## What's Next:

Your report will be sent over to the Nampa Police Person's Crimes Division where it will be assigned to a detective and victim witness coordinator. Within the next few days your victim witness coordinator will contact you to set up an appointment for a forensic interview with your child.

The investigation starts with a good quality interview with your child. It is not best practice to have a police officer conduct the interview with him or her. The Nampa Police Department works closely with CARES; a team of well trained medical professionals from St. Luke's Hospital. The CARES team consists of social workers, forensic nurses and doctors who are specifically trained to interview and examine children who have experienced abuse.



## WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT WHILE AT THE CARES APPOINTMENT?

CARES will take a few minutes to discuss what you know about the abuse. The social worker will then take your child to be interviewed. Parents are not allowed to escort their child to the interview. We find that children will be more forthcoming with information due to a variety of reasons. Rest assured they are very good at what they do and will help your child feel safe while talking.

A second social worker will meet with you during this time to discuss family history and begin to go over available resources for your family.

When the interview is complete the forensic nurse will do a well child check-up. A physical exam *may* occur to assess your child's physical health by checking and documenting any injuries. If your child would like, you may be present for the exam.

Finally, the team will meet with you to go over what was discovered; they will also discuss the remainder of the investigation process.

## WHERE WILL WE GO FOR THE FORENSIC INTERVIEW?

The investigation will take place in one of two locations:

Appointment times depend on availability; but are conducted at 8:00, 10:00 and 12:30 in both locations. Other times are available but are arranged at CARES' discretion. Your victim witness coordinator will inform you of time and location.

## IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE I SHOULD CONSIDER?

- Bring your child's Medicaid or insurance information with you. Since CARES is based out of St. Luke's they will bill insurance or Medicaid for your visit.
- Please be sure your child is not hungry or tired prior to the appointment.
- Try not to display any emotion about what happened in front of your child.
